Short instructions Bluetooth music receiver WM-BT24

Compatible with the following models:

- Audi: (in conjunction with Audi 3G system) A4 (8K) from 2009 2011,
 A5 from 2009 2011, A6 (4F) from 2009, A7 from 2010, A8 (4) from 2009
- Seat: Ibiza, Leon, Altea, Alhambra from 2010
- **Skoda:** Octavia, Rapid, Superb, Yeti from 2010
- VW: Polo 6R / 6C from 2010 2014, Golf 6/7 from 2009 2017, Sportsvan from 2014, Beetle from 2012 2017, Jetta from 2011 2015, Scirocco from 2008 2014, Eos from 2006 2016, Touran from 2007, Tiguan from 2007 2016, Passat from 2008 2014, Sharan from 2011 2015, Touareg from 2011 2015, Phaeton (GP2) from 2009, Amarok from 2010, Multivan (T5 GP) from 2010 2015

Connect the adapter:

- 1. Turn off the ignition and the radio.
- 2. Insert the adapter into the AMI / MMI connection provided in the glove box or the center console (in some vehicle models this connection is located behind a separate flap).
- 3. Turn on the ignition and the radio.
- 4. Then press the Media button (VW) or the Setup button (Audi) and select AUX.

 For Audi in External audio input (In some vehicle models, the AUX input is automatically selected when the adapter is plugged in).
- 5. Establish a Bluetooth connection by enabling Bluetooth pairing in the mobile device and searching for the Bluetooth device ``WM´´.

 The volume on the mobile device should then be set to maximum (then control on the media system possible).
- 6. Now you can play music from your phone or from APPs on your device.

Note

To operate the adapter, an AMI / MMI connection must be present and the AUX input must be enabled. If the AUX input is not recognized, a software update or the activation of a specialist workshop is necessary.

The Bluetooth module supports the A2DP protocol. This connection allows you to enjoy music from your mobile phone or from apps such as mobile phones. Spotify, Deezer, etc. Play. The adapter does not support a hands-free function and operation is exclusively via the mobile device.

Adapter is not found

If you can not find the device "WM" in the Bluetooth search but the adapter is displayed as an AUX device in your AMI / MMI system "External audio source is active" unfortunately you already have a lock code integrated by Audi in the system. In this case, you need an adapter with a separate power supply as it is no longer output from the vehicle via the multimedia interface.
