
Quick Guide Bluetooth Music Receiver WM-BTMIC21

Compatible with the following manufacturers / models with Comand 2.0 Navi-Radio:

- E-Klasse (W/S210) from 1999
- C-Klasse (W/S203) from 2000
- SL-Klasse (R230) from 2001
- S-Klasse (W220) Facelift from 2002
- CL-Klasse (C215) Facelift from 2003
- SL-Klasse (R230) from 2004
- S-Klasse (W220) Facelift from 2003

Connect the adapter:

- 1. Remove the radio (you will find various instructions on the Internet).
- 2. Before disconnecting the plugs from the radio, make sure you have the radio code available to you, as you will need it for the radio after the power interruption
- 3. Plug the MQS extender from the AUX adapter into the radio (marked red in the picture) and connect the jack plug to the jack socket (AUX) on the WM-BTMIC21.
- 4. If the MQS plug is already occupied, you must spinn out the pins from our adapter and pin them into the intended pins (original plug) using the pin assignment on the radio.
- 5. Position the microphone near the driver in the vehicle (steering wheel fairing, dashboard, etc.). Lay the cable and connect the jack plug to the jack socket (MIC) on the WM-BTMIC21. Avoid placing the microphone in the immediate vicinity of or on airbags.



- 6. Now connect the black ground cable to the radio housing or the black cable directly to a ground cable to the radio connection (usually a thick brown cable). Without a good ground connection the function of the adapter is not given.
- 7. Now connect the red cable (ignition plus +12V) to a switched +12V line. As this is usually no longer present behind the radio, the voltage can be taken from the cigarette lighter or the air conditioner (measurement with multimeter necessary). Ignition on = +12V on / ignition off = 0V on.
- 8. Establish a Bluetooth connection by enabling Bluetooth pairing and searching for the Bluetooth device ``WM´´. You should then set the volume on the connected device to full volume.
- 9. Before reinstalling the radio, test the function of the adapter. Turn on the AUX function in the menu.
