

Quick Start Guide Bluetooth Music Receiver WM-BT29

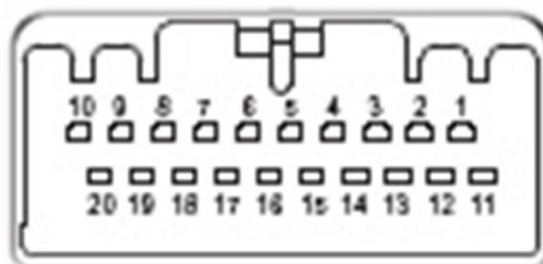
Compatible with the following models:

- Honda Civic year 2006-2013
- Honda CRV year 2008-2013
- Honda Accord (8 generation) year 2008-2013

Connect the adapter:

1. Remove the radio (on the Internet you will find various instructions on this).
2. Before disconnecting the plugs from the radio, make sure that the radio code is available to you as you may need it for the radio after the power cut.
3. Disconnect the 20 pin connector from the radio. If external devices such as a CD changer may be present, this can then no longer be used.
4. Insert the 20-pole expander of the WM-BT29 into the designated connection behind the radio.

5. Now connect the black ground cable to the radio housing or the black cable directly to a ground lead to the radio connection (usually brown thick cable). Without a good ground connection, the function of the adapter is not given.
6. Now connect the red cable (ignition plus + 12V) to a switched + 12V line (measurement with multimeter necessary). Ignition on = + 12V are on / Ignition off = 0V are on.
7. Establish a Bluetooth connection by activating Bluetooth pairing and searching for the ``WM`` Bluetooth device. You should then set the volume to full volume on the connected device.
8. Before reinstalling the radio, test the function of the adapter. To do this, switch on the AUX function via the CD / AUX button on the radio.

For info!

AUX must be unlocked and selectable on the radio. If this is not the case, activation in a specialist workshop is required.
