

Quick Start Guide Bluetooth Music Receiver WM-BTMIC04

Compatible with the following models:

- ALFA ROMEO 159 from year of construction 09/2005
- FIAT 500 from year 10/2007, Fiat Grande Punto (type 199) from year of construction 09/2005
- LANCIA Musa (type 350) from year of construction 09/2004, LANCIA Ypsilon (type 843) from year of construction 10/2003, LANCIA Ypsilon (type 846) from year of production 07/2011

Connect the adapter:

1. For safety reasons and to avoid short circuits, disconnect the vehicle battery during all work on the vehicle electrical system.
2. Remove the radio.
3. Insert the yellow expander of the AUX cable into chamber C1 (outlined in red in the picture).
Then the cable is connected to the SPK output of the Bluetooth adapter.
4. If you have installed a black 20-pin connector in the vehicle, you will also need the adapter WM-4693 (mini-ISO adapter / extension). This can be ordered in our online shop at www.wm-outlet-store.de.



5. Remove the two 8 pin Iso connectors (in picture A and B) from the radio.
6. Now plug the remote plugs into the appropriate sockets of the WM-BTMIC16 and connect the adapter to the radio.
7. Position the microphone near the driver in the vehicle (steering wheel trim, instrument panel, etc.). The cable is then routed to the Bluetooth adapter and connected to the microphone input. **Avoid placing the microphone in the immediate vicinity of or on airbags.**
8. Establish a Bluetooth connection by activating Bluetooth pairing and searching for the ``WM`` Bluetooth device. You should then set the volume to full volume on the connected device.
9. Before reinstalling the radio, test the function of the adapter. To do this, turn on the radio's AUX function and play music with the connected Bluetooth device.
